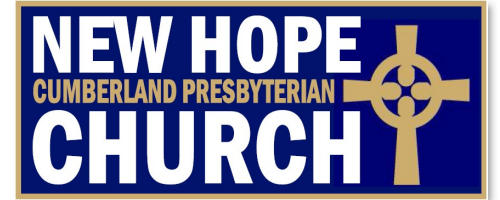
Announcements/Activities/Ministries
