ALL ...In the name of Christ. Amen.**

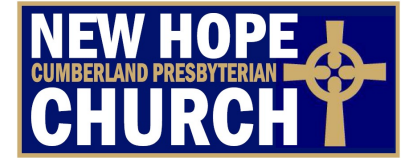

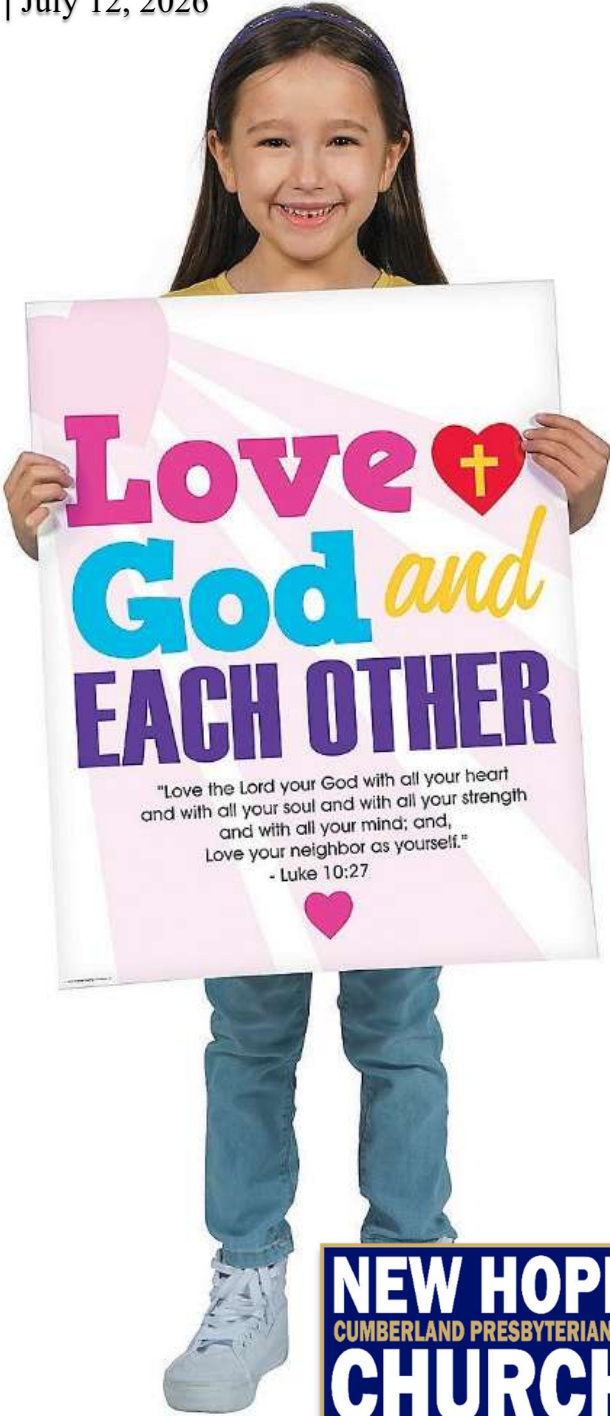
Announcements/Activities/Ministries
